4. Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of this week are Rogation Days, with the usual Litany of the Saints procession starting at 5:30 AM each day, followed by the regular 6:00 AM Mass.
5. Tuesday of this week (May 3, 2005) is also the Feast of the Finding of the Holy Cross. On this day we will place the third and last Blessing on the little Palm Crosses, which will then be available next Sunday.
6. Wednesday of this week is also the Vigil of the Ascension of Our Lord. *It is **NOT** a day of fast or abstinence.*
7. This Wednesday is also the Feast of Saint Monica and the Name Day of our Mother Mary Monica, OSB. Please keep Mother in you very special prayers.
8. Thursday, May 5, 2005, is the Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord, *and is a holy day of obligation*, with Masses in the Abbey Church at 6:00 AM, 8:00 AM, and 7:00 PM.
9. This Thursday is also the first Thursday of May, with Holy Hour and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament ***ONLY IN THE AFTERNOON*** from 3:30 PM to 4:30 PM, in the Abbey Church.
10. Friday, May 6, 2005, is the First Friday of May, with Masses at 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM, and all-day Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament from 10:00 AM until 6:00 PM, in the Abbey Church.
11. The Novena to the Holy Spirit begins on Friday, June 6. Please try to join us in your home chapels in this holy prayer. If ever we have needed the help of the Holy Spirit, it is surely at this moment in time.
12. Saturday, May 7, 2005, is the First Saturday of May, with Masses in the Abbey Church at 6:00 and 8:00 AM.
13. Next Sunday, May 8, 2005, is Mother's Day. We will have our usual Ceremony of the Crowning of Our Lady's statue in the Abbey Church before the 10:00 AM Mass. Miss Sarah Renee Smith will crown Our Lady.
